THIS PROCEDURE WILL ONLY PROGRAM THE REMOTE ASPECT OF YOUR KEY. YOU MUST HAVE THE KEY CUT AND TRANSPONDER PROGRAMMED BY THE DEALER OR LOCKSMITH. IF YOU HAVE A BASIC KEY FOB USE THIS PROCEDURE.

- 1. Collect all remotes that you wish to program. This procedure will erase all previously programmed remotes. You must program all <u>existing and new remotes</u> that you wish to use on the vehicle at this time.
- 2. You have 5 seconds to complete each step. If you take longer than 5 seconds you will need to restart the entire process. You can attempt this process as many times as necessary to complete it.
- 3. Enter vehicle and close all doors
- 4. Repeat the following steps A B C **THREE** times (use the <u>same</u> remote each time for this step, an unprogrammed remote can be used)
 - A. Turn ignition to the **ON** position (II)
 - B. Press the lock button on the remote you are programming
 - C. Turn the ignition to the $\mbox{\bf OFF}$ position (I)
 - **REPEAT STEPS ABC THREE TIMES
- 5. Turn ignition to the ON position (II)
- 6. Using the same remote from step 4 press the LOCK button. At this time the door locks will cycle confirming that the vehicle has *entered programming mode*.
- 7. Using the same remote from step 4 press the LOCK button. At this time the door locks will cycle confirming that the vehicle has *programmed the remote*.
- **If you have more remotes to program follow step 7 for each remote you wish to program. The door locks will cycle to indicate each remote has been programmed. You have 10 seconds to program each additional remote.
- 8. Turn the ignition to the **OFF** position (I)
